Synopsis:

I work as a clinical senior lecturer and consultant gynaecologic oncologist at the West London Gynaecological Cancer Center and perform a range of advanced laparoscopic and radical open surgeries. I carried out the majority of my training in the NW Thames London Deanery and completed my subspecialty training in gynaecologic oncology.

My main professional and academic interests within gynaecologic oncology and particularly cervical cancer/precancer, endometrial cancer and minimal access surgery. I developed an academic interest in the reproductive outcomes after treatment of cervical cancer, precancer and other gynaecologic malignancies, cervical cancer screening and the use of HPV biomarkers in women with abnormalities at screening. My other area of research investigates the role of obesity and insulin resistance in endometrial tumorigenesis.

I completed a PhD Thesis and an MSc in advanced gynaecological endoscopy and gained invaluable experience through formal and informal training sessions on evidence-based medicine, study and clinical trial design, clinical research methodology, biomarker discovery, statistical and meta-analysis of trial data. I now run my own independent research group and research program at Imperial College. I am the author of more than 80 publications in peer-review journals, book chapters and reviews with greater than 3400 citations and h-index of 22. I am involved in five ongoing Cochrane Gynaecological cancer reviews.

I have been awarded forty-two awards, prizes, scholarships, academic distinctions. I have given or co-authored more than 300 presentations at national & international meetings. These included invited lectures at the IFCPC, EFC, International HPV conference (workshop), BGCS, Canadian Association of Obstetricians and Gynaecologists (Quebec), ICOG, RCOG, HSCCP in the UK, Ireland, Greece, France, Morocco, Poland, Canada.
